



Schedule of Changes – in response to points raised at the Strategic Board held on 14<sup>th</sup> June

Reference	Change	Justification
1.1	Delete reference to Suffolk	Wording of this paragraph uses generic geographical terms - East Anglia, Central, Southern and Western England – that are strategic in nature - This paragraph needs to be read in conjunction with subsequent paragraph 1.2
1.2	Amend so that it now reads:  ‘The core focus of the Consortium is the delivery of an East West Rail Link that delivers a step-change in east-west connectivity, linking Oxford, Milton Keynes, Cambridge, Ipswich and Norwich. As well as this core purpose, by linking major national rail routes East West Rail will also enable better north-south connectivity across the whole of the corridor.	Revised wording makes it clear that the core focus of the Consortium includes the linkages to/from Ipswich and Norwich thereby making it clear that the eastern section is a core part of the project.
1.4	Amend sub-paragraph b) so that it now reads:  Develop service linkages more widely across the rail network, beyond England’s Economic Heartland, including (but not limited to) linkages to the west of Oxford, linkages to London and linkages across East Anglia.	Revised wording reinforces how the eastern section is a core to the East West Rail project by providing opportunities to develop wider linkages across East Anglia



2.1	<p>Add additional sentence:</p> <p>The list of members is updated on an annual basis after the Annual General Meeting: the list of members is published on the website.</p>	<p>Additional wording references that a list of current members is published on the website and updated on an annual basis – this reflects the view of the meeting as to the importance of ensuring visibility of individual partners’ interests in the Consortium</p>
3.10	<p>Add additional sentence:</p> <p>Local authority members (including substitute members) of the Consortium are entitled to vote at meetings of the Strategic Board.</p>	<p>Additional wording makes it clear that local authority members have the right to vote at the Strategic Board. Wording makes it clear that where a Consortium partner is represented by a substitute member that representative is able to exercise the partner’s vote</p>
3.11	<p>Amend wording so that it reads as:</p> <p>Meetings of the Strategic Board will rotate between locations to reflect the geography of the corridor</p>	<p>Revised wording confirms that meetings will rotate between locations (as agreed at the meeting)</p>
